1. The competition and exhibition will be staged again this year by the **Hills Photographic Society**.

2. Prizes will be awarded for:

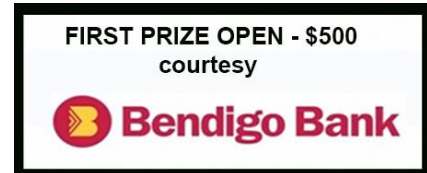
First, second and third places in the **OPEN CATEGORY**.

First, second and third in the **UNDER 18 CATEGORY**.

Best overall B&W or monochrome.

Winner **People's Choice**

Plus a number of Commendations will be made.



3. Results will be announced at the Exhibition opening at 10:30 am on Sunday 29th March.

4. The judge's decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.

5. **Works entered must be prepared ready for hanging.**

6. Framing, where appropriate, is encouraged but is not essential. If not framed steps must be taken to ensure the work is mounted securely on a stiff backing, will hang flat and securely and will not require further treatment by exhibition staff. Please use a cord fixed firmly at the back.

We shall not have any works displayed on a table. NOTE: Photos unable to be hung **WILL** be excluded.

7. Each piece must be clearly labelled on the back with the artist's name, the title of the piece, the category entered and, if for sale, the stated price.

8. **Entries close Friday 20th March. (SEE THE SEPARATE ENTRY FORM FOR DETAILS ON ENTERING)**

9. Entries are limited to **FOUR** per exhibitor and the overall size no larger than **70cm x 60cm**.

All others **must** be delivered on Saturday 28th March to the Emerald Community House Hall between 10am and 12pm.
