- CONSISTS OF TWO DIFFERENT PLANES - VERTICAL & FLAT
- CONSIDER COLOURS, TEXTURES & TONES
- CARDBOARD, FABRIC, WOOD, WALLPAPER ETC. ETC.ETC.





# 3. PROPS

- CHOOSE A FEW GOOD QUALITY OPTIONS
- RAID CUPBOARDS AND DRAWERS
- LOOK IN OP SHOPS AND GARAGES SALES
- PLATES, BOWLS, CUTLERY & TEA TOWELS
- DON'T BUY ANYTHING SHINY





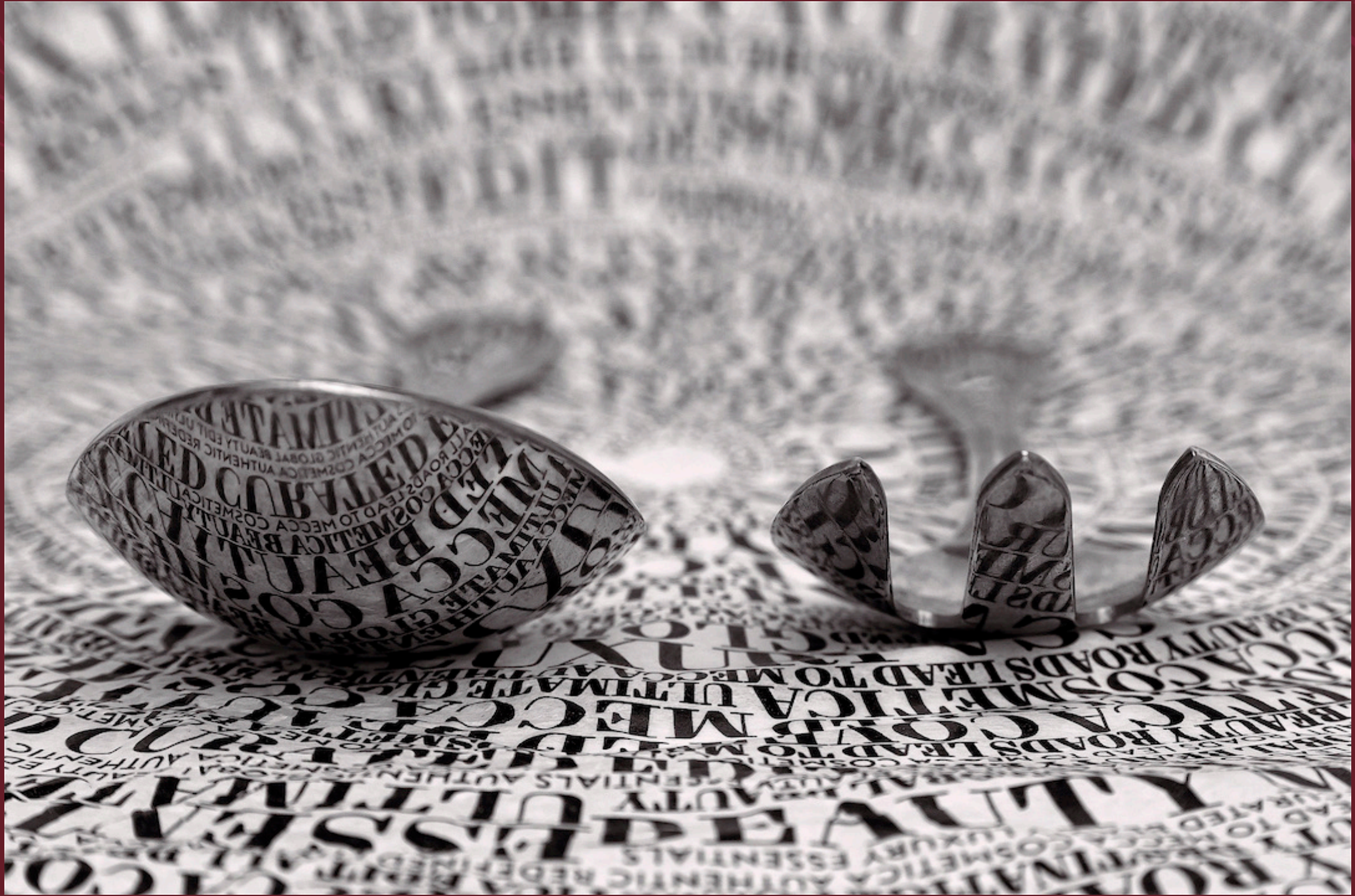
# 4. LAYOUT

- DECIDE HOW INDIVIDUAL ELEMENTS ARE STAGED IN RELATION TO EACH OTHER
- DECIDE HOW THE CAMERA WILL BE POSITIONED
- DECIDE ON LAYOUT OPTION - FRONT ON OR FLAT LAY
- IS IT GOING TO BE A CLOSEUP OR SHOW MORE OF THE SCENE
- DECIDE WHERE THE LIGHTING IS COMING FROM
